## Course Includes:

- ♪ Singing, rhythm, and movement activities
- ♪ Development of melodic awareness, listening skills, language, coordination, memory, social skills, self-expression, and self-confidence
- ♪ A CD recording of lullabies, action songs, and nursery rhymes used in class that parents can repeat at home to reinforce the learning process

## Prerequisites:

- ♪ No prior musical training or knowledge necessary
- ♪ All participants are encouraged to listen to the CD, *Lullabies, Action Songs, and Rhymes* before the first class session.

## Class Guidelines:

- ♪ Children ages 0-3 are eligible for participation in "A Sound Start!" and children ages 4 and 5 are eligible for "Sound Adventures!"
- ♪ While it is best to have one child/one parent per family participate in each class, special exceptions may be made.
- ♪ If two parents attend with one child, one parent will participate with the child, and the other parent is welcome to observe the class, free of charge.
